Tournament Rules

Participants and Eligibility:

Open to all current high school students in grades 9-12, male and female. No TBF or SAF membership required. Each team must supply boat and boat captain. Boat captains may operate the trolling motor and net all fish.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees shall be \$40.00 per team. Entry fees for the "Kaylee Graves Benefit Fishing Tournament" are to be paid at the ramp before launch. 100% of all entry fees collected will go directly to the Graves' family to help with medical expenses.

Prizes:

Plaques will be awarded for the teams coming in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in total weight. There will also be one plaque awarded to the student who brings in the Big Bass of the tournament. Also, there will be one "Team Championship" plaque awarded on total combined weight of the three heaviest bags of each school entered.

Off Limits:

There is no off limits period for this tournament.

Tournament Hours:

Tournament hours will be from safe light to 3 pm. We reserve the right to assign flights and change hours if necessary.

Flights:

The number of flights will be determined by the number of entries.

Flight #1: Boats 1-25 (weigh-in @ 3 pm)

Flight #2: Boats 26-50 (weigh-in @ 3:15 pm)

Flight #3: Boats 51-75 (weigh-in @ 3:30 pm)

Flight #4: Boats 76-100 (weigh-in @ 3:45 pm)

Boat numbers will be assigned in order of entries received as you sign in the morning of the tournament which will determine launch sequence.

Safety:

Safe boating conduct must be observed at all times. Each competitor and boat captain is required to wear a Coast Guard approved personal floatation device, securely fastened, at all times when the boat is being propelled by the combustion engine. Failure to do so is grounds for disqualification of the offending team's catch. Running lights must be operational and turned on at the blast-off of the tournament. Each competitor's boat must be equipped with a livewell system capable of keeping a tournament limit of bass alive.

Sportsmanship:

Each contestant is expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy and conservation. No team may fish within 50 yards of any other boat which is anchored and the trolling motor is up. Furthermore, no team may fish within 25 yards of any other boat without the other boater's permission.

Tackle and Fishing Methods:

Only artificial baits may be used. No live or cut bait permitted. Each competitor may only use one (1) rod at a time. No more than one line in the water at a time per angler. Trolling with the combustion motor is not permitted. No competitor may leave the boat to land or catch a fish.

Scoring:

A limit of 5 bass (largemouth or spotted) may be weighed in. All bass must be 14" in minimum length. Lengths will be measured with mouth closed. A short fish brought to the scales will not be weighed and will result in a 1 pound penalty. Dead fish will be penalized .25 (1/4) pound. All culling must be done at the time the 6th fish is caught. No team may continue

fishing with more than the tournament limit in the livewell at any time during the tournament, with the exception of dead fish that is not included in their limit.

Weigh-in Procedures:

Weigh-in will be on a first come, first serve basis. Once fish have been presented to a tournament official to be weighed-in all fish become property of Bullard Panthers Fishing Club and no additional fish may be brought to the scales. Teams not weighing any fish are still required to check in with tournament officials in order to account for all teams. Once a team member has checked in or left the boat for the purpose of checking in, neither team member may fish or continue fishing.
