<u>Fish Limits</u>		<u>Boundaries</u>
Fish size: inches and over. Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Culling a dead fish is not legal. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.
